Congratulations to first place winner, D. William Subin for his piece, *New Orleans Street Band*.

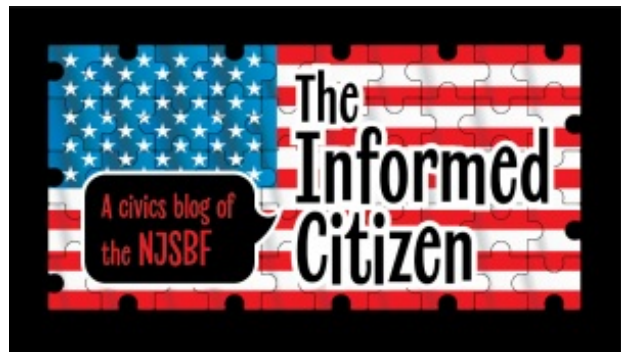
