

PARENTING & HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The following holidays shall be alternated between the parties each year. Unless otherwise indicated, those holidays shall run from 10:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

1) Christmas/New Year's:— IF CHILD IS OF SCHOOL AGE OR ATTENDING SCHOOL—

Christmas Break— Christmas Break shall be divided as follows: December 23rd (or end of school) at 6:00 p.m. until December 26th at 2:00 p.m.; December 26th at 2:00 p.m. until January 1st at 6:00 p.m. Mother shall have first half in even years, Father shall have first half in odd years.

OR

— IF CHILD IS NOT IN SCHOOL OR OF SCHOOL AGE —

Christmas Eve, December 24th, 6:00 p.m. to Christmas Day, December 25th, 2:00 p.m. (Mother odd years/Father even years)

Christmas Day, December 25th, 2:00 p.m. to December 26th, 6:00 p.m. (Mother even years/Father odd years)

New Year's Eve Day, December 31st, at 6:00 p.m. to New Year's Day, January at 12:00 p.m. (Mother odd years/Father even years)

New Year's Day, January 1st from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Mother odd years/Father even years)

2) Martin Luther King Day (Mother even years/Father odd years)

3) President's Day (Mother even years/Father odd years)

4) Easter Saturday through Easter Sunday (Mother even years/Father odd years)

5) Spring Break (if child is of school age) — The parties shall equally divide Spring, break with the plaintiff having the first half and defendant having the second half. For example, if Spring break consists of eight (8) days, plaintiff shall have the children during the first four days and the defendant shall have the children for the last four days.

6) Memorial Day (Mother odd years/Father even years)

7) July 4th (Mother even years/Father odd years)

8) Labor Day (Mother odd years/Father even years)

9) Halloween (Mother even years/Father odd years) from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

10) Thanksgiving Day and Friday after Thanksgiving (Mother even years/Father odd years)

11) Vacation — Each parent shall be entitled to three (3) weeks of vacation with the children. Each party shall notify the other of their request for summer parenting time with the child by April 30th of each year and the dates and place of said visitation. Mother shall have first choice in odd years of the three (3) weeks she chooses and father shall have first choice in even years of the three (3) weeks he chooses. Each party shall provide 30 days notice before any vacation time.

SPECIAL DAYS

12) Father's Birthday to Father (4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.)

13) Mother's Birthday to Mother (4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.)

14) Mother's Day to Mother

15) Father's Day to Father

16) Child's Birthday — Non-custodial parent to have child from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. unless otherwise agreed to by and between the parties.

COMMUNICATION

17) The parties shall be permitted contact with the children by text message, email, webcam and/or telephone when the child is with the other parent, once per day, for 15 minutes between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
